

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA AMENDING ARTICLE I, SECTION 13-101 AND ARTICLE VIII, SECTION 13-2802 OF CHAPTER 13 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NORMAN BY ADDING CONDITIONS FOR PERMIT ISSUANCE AND PROVISIONS FOR HOURS OF OPERATION AND CONDITIONS FOR DOOR-TO-DOOR PEDDLERS AND SOLICITORS; AND PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

§ 1. That Sections 13-101 and 13-2802 of Article XXVIII of Chapter 13 of the Code of the City of Norman shall be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 13-101. Application for License.

(a) All persons required to procure a license under the provisions of this chapter shall submit an application for such license to the Clerk or his representative.

(b) Such application shall be upon forms provided by the Clerk, and shall be accompanied by:

- (1) An affidavit to be sworn to by the applicant;
- (2) A disclosure of all information necessary to comply with the applicable article of this chapter;
- (3) Any other information which the Clerk shall find to be reasonably necessary to the fair administration of this chapter; and
- (4) The full amount of the applicable fees.

(c) A license/permit under this Chapter shall not be issued to an applicant that owes delinquent sales tax, Municipal Court fees or fines, utility bills, or any other amount properly due and owing to the City of Norman.

Sec. 13-2802. – Invitation required to enter posted premises. Regulations for Operation.

No peddler or solicitor shall enter any premises or attempt to peddle or solicit where the owner or occupant of such premises has indicated his desire not to be contacted for sales or solicitations by the placing of a "NO SOLICITORS" sign on those premises, and such entrance or attempt to peddle or solicit shall constitute a trespass upon private property.

Door-to-door peddlers and solicitors may only operate from the hours of 9:00 am to 8:00 pm or sunset whichever is earlier.

§ 2. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance, except that the effective date provision shall not be severable from the operative provisions of the ordinance.
