

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, APPROPRIATING CARES ACT REIMBURSEMENT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30,000 RECEIVED FROM THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA FROM THE GENERAL FUND MISCELLANEOUS GRANT REIMBURSEMENTS ACCOUNT TO BE USED FOR SMALL BUSINESS RELIEF GRANTS.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act was enacted by the Federal Government to provide financial relief to state and local governments negatively impacted by the COVID-19 crisis based on guidelines established by the Federal Government; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, approximately \$9,600,000 has been made available to the City of Norman to reimburse the City's previous expenses related COVID-19; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, Norman City Council in its meeting of October 29, 2020, appropriated \$6,525,000 of these funds to go towards the Senior Center (\$4,800,000), Room Tax Fund organizations (\$1,075,000), reimburse City COVID related expenses (\$600,000), and (\$50,000) for first responders related activities; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, Norman City Council in its Special Session on December 1, 2020, appropriated \$1,000,000 to be used for small business relief grants; and
- § 5. WHEREAS, 628 applications were received and 103 applications received a score of 73 or more points, which was the break that presented itself; and
- § 6. WHEREAS, an additional \$30,000 would allow the top 103 applications to be funded and close out this part of the program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 7. WHEREAS, it is recommended that \$30,000 be appropriated from the General Fund Miscellaneous Reimbursements account to the following account:
