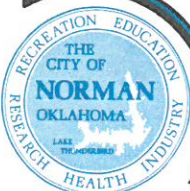


A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
NORMAN, OKLAHOMA ADOPTING THE
STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN AS A PART
OF THE OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF
ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REQUIREMENTS
FOUND IN GENERAL PERMIT OKR04.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the City of Norman was designated pursuant to Section 122.32(a)(1) of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations as a Phase II Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System ("MS4"); and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the City of Norman is required to meet Phase II Storm Water regulations as promulgated by the Environmental Protection Agency and enforced by the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, DEQ issued General Permit OKR04 for Stormwater Discharges Associated with Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems in Small Cities, Urbanized Areas, and Other County Areas in the State of Oklahoma on February 8, 2005; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, General Permit OKR04 was reauthorized and became effective November 1, 2015; and
- § 5. WHEREAS, the City submitted a Notice of Intent and supporting documentation as part of the OKR04 application process on January 29, 2016; and
- § 6. WHEREAS, DEQ issued Authorization OKR040015 to the City on March 17, 2017; and
- § 7. WHEREAS, Authorization OKR040015 requires that the City develop a Stormwater Management Plan, which describes how the City will comply with the general requirements of General Permit OKR04; and
- § 8. WHEREAS, the Stormwater Management Plan is complete and ready for adoption by the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN,

§ 9. That the City of Norman hereby adopts the Stormwater Management Plan as a part of the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality requirements found in General Permit OKR04.
