

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, AMENDING SECTION 15-109 OF CHAPTER 15 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NORMAN TO INCREASE THE MONETARY THRESHOLD IN THE DEFINITION OF PETIT LARCENY FROM NOT IN EXCESS OF FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) TO LESS THAN ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00) TO BE CONSISTENT WITH STATE LAW; AND PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

§ 1. That Section 15-109 of Chapter 15 of the Code of the City of Norman, Oklahoma, shall be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 15-109. - Petit Larceny.

Petit larceny is the taking of personal property of a value less than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), such taking being accomplished by fraud or stealth, and with the intent to deprive another thereof, and when the property is not taken from the person of another.

§ 2. SEVERABILITY. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason found to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decisions shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance or any part thereof.
