

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, APPROPRIATING \$14,625 FROM
THE PARK LAND FUND BALANCE FOR IMPROVEMENTS
TO SUMMIT LAKES PARK.

- § 1. WHEREAS, in 1994, the City of Norman began collecting park development fees in the amount of \$150 for every new residential building permit with \$75 apportioned to community park development and \$75 to neighborhood park development; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the neighborhood park portion of the fees must be spent on the neighborhood park in the area from which they were collected and the community park portion may be expended only at the six community parks, Andrews, Griffin, Reaves, Sutton, Saxon, and Ruby Grant Parks; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, based on the current evaluation of Summit Lakes Park and in response to feedback from local residents, one of the top priority items is to add shade to the playground at the park; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, Staff is recommending an appropriation from the Park Land Fund Balance to pay the majority of the costs associated with installing a shade structure over the playground at Summit Lakes Park and any costs for this structure not covered by this appropriation will be paid from the annual Park Playground Equipment account.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 5. That the following appropriation be made for the reasons as stated above:
