A PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, PROCLAIMING THE WEEK OF April 22 THROUGH 26, 2013, AS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT WEEK IN THE CITY OF NORMAN.

- § 1.
