

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, PROHIBITING THE DISTRIBUTION OR SALE FOR PUBLIC CONSUMPTION OF INTOXICATING OR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, AT ANY PUBLIC PARK OR RECREATIONAL FACILITY IN THE CITY OF NORMAN EXCLUDING THE FIREHOUSE ARTS STATION, THE HISTORICAL MUSEUM, THE SOONER THEATRE, WESTWOOD PARK, THE SANTA FE DEPOT, LEGACY PARK, REAVES PARK, ANDREWS PARK, AND LIONS PARK.

- § 1. WHEREAS, in order to set forth, define and more clearly delineate policy guidance for the Governing Body, the administration and the staff, the City Council of Norman, Oklahoma, adopted Resolution R-8687-95 on June 30, 1987, which prohibited the distribution or sale for public consumption of any intoxicating or alcoholic beverage at any public park or recreational facility except for the Firehouse Art Station, the Historical Museum, the Sooner Theatre, Westwood Park and the Santa Fe Depot; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, Legacy Park was opened in September 2015 and because it is a passive park that includes an outdoor amphitheater designed to accommodate a variety of public and private events, including concerts and weddings, the City Council of Norman, Oklahoma, adopted Resolution R-1516-31 excluding it from the general prohibition related to the distribution or sale for public consumption of any alcoholic beverage; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, other parks in the City have also been identified for possible exclusion from the general prohibition contained in Resolution R-8687-95 because of their use as a host property for a number of events in the community.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 4. That, from and after the adoption of this resolution, it shall be the policy of the City of Norman that:

The City of Norman Parks and Recreation Department will prohibit the distribution or sale for public consumption of any alcoholic beverages at any public park or recreational facility for which the Norman Parks and Recreation Department has scheduling responsibility, excluding the Firehouse Arts Station, the Historical Museum, the Sooner Theatre, Westwood Park, the Santa Fe Depot, Legacy Park, Reaves Park, Andrews Park and Lions Park.
