WHEREAS, the City owns and operates the Animal Welfare Center, a center located in Norman that serves, among other things, as a shelter for pets and facilitates adoptions for said pets; and

WHEREAS, the City sought proposals for Professional Veterinary Services to be provided for animals that come into the care of the Animal Welfare Center ("AWC") including both scheduled care and emergency care.

Now, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises containing herein, the Parties hereto agree as follows:

I. Obligations of the Veterinarian:

- A. Care to be Provided: Veterinarian agrees to provide scheduled care, emergency care and intensive care as needed.
- B. Veterinarian shall visit the AWC at least one (1) day per week to evaluate and/or screen animals at the AWC for medical conditions or medical needs.
- C. Veterinarian shall review the AWC's policies and procedures on an ongoing basis including, but not limited to, the intake procedures, vaccination protocol, parasite treatment, and disinfection processes to ensure the AWC is providing sufficient care and treatment to intake animals.
- D. All such services shall be provided at the price provided in the Clinic's proposal, attached hereto as Exhibit A. If a service is required that is not listed in Exhibit A, Veterinarian shall provide pricing to and obtain approval from the AWC Supervisor, or his designee, prior to providing such service.
- E. The Clinic will invoice the City for each visit in which services under this Agreement are performed.

II. Obligations of the City:

- A. Scheduled Care: If an animal requires non-emergency care, AWC Staff will schedule an appointment with the Veterinarian prior to bring the animal in for services.
- B. Emergency Care: If an animal requires emergency care, AWC Staff will notify Veterinarian prior to bringing the animal to the Veterinarian for care.
- C. AWC Staff will deliver all animals needing care under this Agreement to Veterinarian and pick up the animals once released from the Veterinarian's care.
- D. Invoices for services performed by the Veterinarian shall be paid no later than thirty (30) days from the date of receipt.
- III. <u>Term</u>. The initial term of this Agreement will expire on June 30, 2015, with an option to renew up to four (4) consecutive one (1) year terms, subject to the Veterinarian's satisfactory performance and the availability of appropriated funds in each applicable fiscal year.
- IV. <u>Termination</u>. This contract may be terminated at any time, with or without cause, upon sixty (60) days written notice to the other party.

V. General Provisions

- A. Veterinarian shall perform in a good and professional manner the services identified in the Agreement. This Agreement shall include the Request for Proposals issued by the City, the Veterinarian's Response to the Request for Proposals, and this Agreement. If any conflict exists between these documents, this Agreement shall control.
- B. Veterinarian warrants that it understands the currently known hazards and suspected hazards which are presented to persons working with animals. Veterinarian further warrants that it will perform all services under this Agreement in a safe, efficient, and lawful manner using industry-accepted practices, and in full compliance with all applicable State and Federal laws governing activities under this Agreement.
- C. <u>Notice</u>: Any notice, demand, or request required by or made pursuant to this Agreement shall be deemed properly made if personally delivered in writing or deposited in the United States mail, postage prepaid, to the address specified below:

Nothing contained herein shall be construed to restrict the transmission of routine communications between representatives of the City and the Veterinarian.

D. Indemnification: The Veterinarian agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the City, its officers, servants, and employees, from and against any and all liability, loss, damage, cost, and expense (including attorneys' fees and accountants' fees) caused by an error, omission, or negligent act of the Veterinarian in the performance of services under this Agreement. City agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Veterinarian, its officers, servants, and employees, from and against any and all liability. loss, damage, cost, and expense (including attorneys' fees and accountants' fees) caused by an error, omission, or negligent act of the City in the performance of services under this Agreement, provided such indemnification shall be applicable only to the extent sovereign immunity has been waived pursuant to Oklahoma law. The Veterinarian and the city each agree to promptly service notice on the other party of any claims arising hereunder, and shall cooperate in the defense of such claims. The acceptance by City or its representatives of any certification of insurance providing for coverage other than as required in this Agreement to be furnished by the Veterinarian shall in no event be deemed a waiver of any of the provisions of this indemnity provision. None of the foregoing provisions shall deprive the City of any action, right, or remedy otherwise available to City at common law.
