

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, CLOSING A PORTION OF A UTILITY EASEMENT AND BUILDING SETBACK LINE LOCATED IN THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION THIRTY-FOUR (34), TOWNSHIP NINE NORTH (9), RANGE TWO (2) WEST OF THE INDIAN MERIDIAN, NORMAN, CLEVELAND COUNTY, OKLAHOMA; AND PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 1. That, pursuant to Resolution Number R-8182-66, John and Patricia Bridges, the owners of the subject property, have petitioned the City to have the west three (3) feet of the platted utility easement and building line closed; and,
- § 2. That, also pursuant to Resolution Number R-8182-66, the proper notice has been given, and the maps, memorandums and other items required by said Resolution have been presented to this Council; and
- § 3. That, also pursuant to Resolution Number R-8182-66, a public hearing has been held regarding said closing; and
- § 4. That, the west three (3) feet of the east twelve (12) feet (platted utility easement and building line) of Lot 9, Block 1, SUMMIT LAKES VILLAS, SECTION 1, Norman, Cleveland County, Oklahoma, is hereby closed.
- § 5. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
