City funds are invested in interest bearing accounts and investment securities, as directed by the City's Investment Policy. Rates of return on these investments relate directly to current Treasury and Money Market rates. Total funds on deposit of \$142.5 million as of 10/31/12 are represented by working capital cash balances of all City funds of approximately \$75.04 million, outstanding encumbrances of \$29.2 million, General Obligation Bond proceeds of \$21.23 million, NUA revenue bond proceeds of \$9.6 million, NMA bond proceeds of \$813 thousand, and UNP TIF reserve amounts of \$6.62 million.
