Know all men by these presents that NASH CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC., as Principal, and North American Specialty Insurance Company , a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New Hampshire , and authorized to transact business in the State of Oklahoma, as SURETY, are held and firmly bound unto THE CITY OF NORMAN, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Oklahoma, herein called CITY, in the sum of SIX HUNDRED AND NINE THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SIX AND 00/100 (DOLLARS) (\$609,626.00), such sum being equal to the contract price and being in force for a period of one year from the date of the acceptance of the below described improvements by the City Council, and thereafter for the sum of NINETY-ONE THOUSAND, FOUR HUNDRED AND FORTY-THREE AND 90/100 DOLLARS (\$91,443.90), such sum being not less than fifteen percent (15%) of the total contract price of said improvements for a period of four years thereafter, for the payment of which sum PRINCIPAL and SURETY bind themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, jointly and severally.

WHEREAS, the conditions of this obligation are such that the PRINCIPAL, being the lowest and best bidder on the following project;

BID 2021-4 STREET MAINTENANCE BOND PROGRAM PICKARD AVENUE RECONSTRUCTION

has entered into a written CONTRACT (<u>K-2021-5</u>) with the CITY OF NORMAN, dated this <u>22nd</u> day of <u>September</u>, 20 <u>20</u> for the erection and construction of this PROJECT, that CONTRACT being incorporated herein by references as if fully set forth; and

WHEREAS, under the ordinances of the CITY the PRINCIPAL is required to furnish to the CITY a maintenance bond covering said construction of this PROJECT, the bond to include the terms and provisions hereinafter set forth, as a condition precedent to final acceptance of the PROJECT.

NOW, THEREFORE, if the PRINCIPAL shall keep and maintain, subject to normal wear and tear, the construction, except for defects not occasioned by improper workmanship, materials, or failure to protect new work until it is accepted, and if the PRINCIPAL shall promptly repair, without notice from the CITY or expense to the CITY any and all defects arising from improper workmanship, materials, or failure to protect new work until it is accepted; all for a period of five (5) years from the date of the written final acceptance by the CITY, then this obligation shall be null and void. The amount of the Maintenance Bond shall be 100 % of the contract amount for a period of one year from the date of the acceptance, and 15% of the total contract price of said improvements for a period of four years thereafter. Otherwise, this obligation shall remain in full force and effect at all times.

Provided further, however, that upon neglect, failure or refusal of the PRINCIPAL to maintain or make any needed repairs upon the construction on the PROJECT, as set out in the preceding paragraph, within ten (10) days after the mailing of notice to the PRINCIPAL by letter deposited in the United States Post Office at Norman, Oklahoma, addressed to the PRINCIPAL at the address set forth below, then the PRINCIPAL and SURETY shall jointly and severally be liable to the CITY for the cost and expense for making such repair, or otherwise maintaining the said construction.

It is further expressly agreed and understood by the parties hereto that no changes or alterations in said CONTRACT and no deviations from the plan or mode of procedure herein fixed shall have the effect of releasing the sureties, or any of them, from the obligations of this Bond.
