

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, APPROPRIATING \$19,779 FROM THE STATE SEIZURES AND RESTITUTIONS FUND BALANCE TO FUND UNIFORM AND EQUIPMENT NEEDS FOR THE NORMAN POLICE HONOR GUARD.

- § 1. WHEREAS, in 1991, the Norman Police Department established an all-volunteer honor guard which included officers and paramedics who banded together to provide ceremonial funeral support for public safety personnel and their immediate families; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the Norman Police Honor Guard currently has 19 authorized members consisting of 18 commissioned officers and one police Chaplain and these team members represented the City at 25 events during 2013; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, a uniform or equipment purchase for the honor guard has never occurred and the desire is to use money from the State Seizures and Restitution Fund Balance to upgrade the team's uniform to a distinctive, strictly ceremonial dress similar to but distinguishable from the standard Class-A police uniform.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:
