Rates of return on these investments relate directly to current Treasury and Money Market rates. Total funds on deposit of \$172.91 million as of 06/30/13 are represented by working capital cash balances of all City funds of approximately \$ 84.81 million, outstanding encumbrances of \$37.06 million, General Obligation Bond proceeds of \$35.93 million, NUA revenue bond proceeds of \$8.15 million.
