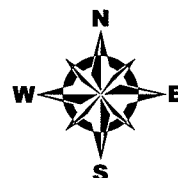


Protest Map

Pre-Development Discussion of a Proposed Special Use for a Bar


