On Thursday June 4, 2020 approximately 2:50pm I was at the Sonic Drive in restaurant located at 9300 N. Rockwell Avenue in Oklahoma City, OK 73102. I had received my food and had backed out of my parking space to leave when Jason Smith the administrative assistant fire chief for the Norman fire department backed into my car while on duty in a Norman fire emergency response truck. His truck initiated impact with his rear passenger corner bumper on the driver rear quarter panel just behind my rear driver side door scraping and crinkling my car for about a foot and a half section. When he realized he had made impact he proceeded to pull forward into the food bay he was previously parked in. We were both originally parked in food bays opposite sides of each other. I then pulled into a food bay next to him to get out of the way and exchange information/wait for the police. I called the police at 2:59pm. Mr. Smith did not provide any insurance information or even his name I had to research and find his information myself. I did ask if he was on duty and he said yes. I also overheard him call his supervisor saying he would be late because he had just backed into someone (me). We proceeded to take pictures of each other's vehicle damage and wait for the police. When officer J. Gibson of the Oklahoma City police department Hefner division arrived he gathered information and said there would be a report in a few days on the accident. All parties were free to go at this time.
