

A PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, PROCLAIMING THE WEEK OF JANUARY 29 THROUGH FEBRUARY 4, 2017, AS CATHOLIC SCHOOLS WEEK IN THE CITY OF NORMAN.

- § 1. WHEREAS, understanding our children are our future and the City of Norman has made education of our young citizens a top priority; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the Archdiocese of Oklahoma currently has 18 elementary schools and 3 secondary schools of which All Saints Catholic Scholl in Norman is one; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, All Saints Catholic School exists to teach children to know, love, and serve God through academic pursuits and service to others which focuses on providing a faith-based education that holds its students to high academic standards and helps each child to reach his or her full potential through education and by actively practicing good citizenship; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, to recognize the presence of our Catholic School in Norman and the contribution they make to the current and future well-being of families of the City of Norman and surrounding areas, Catholic Schools Week 2017 will be observed under the banner or theme of “Catholic Schools: Communities of Faith, Knowledge, and Service,” and
- § 5. WHEREAS, Catholic Schools Week will be celebrated at All Saints Catholic School beginning with an open house on January 29th and a variety of special activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 6. Do hereby proclaim the week of January 29 through February 4, 2017, as Catholic Schools Week in the City of Norman and urge all citizens to be aware of the significant impact that Catholic Schools have had in improving the quality of life for Norman’s families and in encouraging Norman’s young people to achieve their life goals through Faith, Knowledge, and Service.
