

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, APPROPRIATING \$60,000 FROM
THE ROOM TAX FUND BALANCE FOR RENOVATION OF
THE OUTDOOR TENNIS COURTS AT THE 12TH AVENUE
RECREATION CENTER.

- § 1. WHEREAS, approximately 25% of Room Tax revenues are to be used specifically for capital improvements in the Parks and Recreation Department and there is a current balance of approximately \$180,000 in the Room Tax Finance Balance available for projects; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, in recent years, the sport of pickleball has gained popularity locally and nationally and there are many active league and casual players in Norman who play year-round in local weekly meets and at regional and national events; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, recently, local league administrators have approached the City about converting the 4 outdoor tennis courts at 12th Avenue Recreation Center into pickleball courts and it is believed that \$60,000 would be sufficient to repair, clean, resurface and then re-apply the lines and nets for two refurbished tennis courts and six new full-time pickleball courts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 4. WHEREAS, Staff is recommending an appropriation from the Room Tax Fund Balance to make the necessary improvements. and
- § 5. That the above-described appropriation be made for the reason as stated above.
