

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA
APPROVING A MODIFICATION TO THE STREAM BANKS OF
BROOKHAVEN CREEK AT MAIN STREET AS PART OF THE
MAIN STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the residents of Norman voted in favor of a Bond Election in August, 2012, to finance the local share of eight transportation/storm water improvements projects, including the Main Street Bridge over Brookhaven Creek Project (the "Project"); and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the Project includes the replacement of the bridge on Main Street that spans Brookhaven Creek; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, replacement of the bridge over Brookhaven Creek requires modification of the stream bank along Brookhaven Creek for a distance of approximately 200 feet upstream and 2,700 feet downstream to ensure the hydraulic capacity of the bridge is maintained; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, a Conditional Floodplain Permit was granted to the City for this work in accordance with Section 22:429.1 of the City's Zoning Ordinance on March 7, 2016; and,
- § 5. WHEREAS, Section 22:429.1(4)(b)(17) of the City's Zoning Ordinance requires any modifications to the stream banks within the regulatory floodway other than routine maintenance by the City, be approved by City Council in addition to approval by the Floodplain Permit Review Committee, before a final Floodplain Permit may be issued.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 6. That, the proposed modifications of the stream banks for Brookhaven Creek upstream and downstream of West Main Street are approved.
- § 7. That, Floodplain Permit No. 558A be granted as approved by the Floodplain Permit Committee without condition.
