Mr. Floyd

The following is a revision for additional work done on the original proposal revised and sent to you on June 2, 2016. During the course, and fulfillment of, the original scope of services it has become apparent, and agreed upon city staff, that the scope should be revised to include additional services necessary to design and develop the street project. The following is additional services write up for your consideration:

Waterline Revisions: Revised to included 2 new additional waterlines not previously considered part of the original project. One existing line on the east side of railroad has been revised and redesigned for an upgrade to an 8" waterline. The existing 6" line on the north side of acres next to library has been revised and upgraded to an 8" waterline. (\$8,000)

Redesign of James Garner Ave: JG was redesigned from normal crowned section to be inverted and allow for bioswales in boulevard areas. Redesign of storm system necessary as part of revision. (\$6,000)

Additional Bio-swale Analysis: Bio-swales in boulevard green space will be designed and storm calculations performed per requirements and specifications set forth by the city. (\$14,000)
