LETTER OF NO OBJECTION TO ENCROACH ON A PORTION OF THE UTILITY EASEMENT FOR AN EXISTING DETACHED GARAGE.

THIS REQUEST IS TO ENCROACH ON THE UTILITY EASEMENT EXISTING ALONG THE SOUTHSIDE OF THE PROPERTY LINE OF 620 TULSA STREET, NORMAN, CLEVELAND COUNTY, OKLAHOMA. SW/4 SEC32, T09N, R02W.

Oklahoma Natural Gas Company does not object to the City of Norman issuing a permit for the purpose described above.

We do have a natural gas distribution main and natural gas service line in the area. Because of this, we request OKIE ONE CALL SYSTEM (840-5032 OR 1-800-522-6543) be contacted a minimum of forty-eight (48) hours before any excavation.

Should Oklahoma Natural Gas Company or its contractors need access to their pipeline or facilities in the utility easement the property owner is responsible to move structure or Oklahoma Natural Gas Company or its contractor have the right to move structure in case of an emergency and Oklahoma Natural Gas Company or its contractor will not liable for any damage to structure should any occur.
