

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, CLOSING THE NORTH THIRTY-FIVE (35) FEET OF THE SEVENTY (70) FOOT RIGHT-OF-WAY KNOWN AS FRANKLIN COURT (PLATTED AS MAIN STREET) LOCATED IN FRANKLIN ADDITION TO NORMAN, CLEVELAND COUNTY, OKLAHOMA; AND PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 1. That, pursuant to Resolution Number R-8182-66, Shari Vaughn, owner of the subject property, has petitioned the City to have part of a seventy foot (70') right-of-way within Block 4, FRANKLIN ADDITION closed; and,
- § 2. That, also pursuant to Resolution Number R-8182-66, the proper notice has been given, and the maps, memorandums and other items required by said Resolution have been presented to this Council; and
- § 3. That, also pursuant to Resolution Number R-8182-66, a public hearing has been held regarding said closing; and
- § 4. That, the north thirty-five (35) feet of the seventy (70) foot right-of-way known as Franklin Court (platted as Main Street) located adjacent to Lots 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, and 17 to the East Boundary in Block 4 of FRANKLIN ADDITION to Norman, Cleveland County, Oklahoma according to the recorded plat thereof, is hereby closed.
- § 5. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
