## Political Sign Regulations

$\square$ No signs can ever be placed within the sight triangle.
$\square$ No signs shall be placed within any public right-of-way [except as provided for singlefamily homes] that has been dedicated to the City by plat, easement, or statute, nor any median, boulevard, street, road, or parkway, nor any public or private park
$\square$ Signs should only be placed on privately owned property \& you should obtain permission of the property owner prior to placing the sign

## Political Sign Regulations

$\square$ No signs may be placed within 300 feet of any polling site
$\square$ Signs can not cause a sight obstruction or traffic hazard at any time
$\square$ In regard to single-family dwellings only, political signs may be placed within the right-of-way in front of or along the side of any such dwelling, provided that the permission of the property owner has been obtained and such signs are no wider than thirty (30) inches or taller than twenty (20) inches in height.

## Political Sign Regulations

$\square$ On major thoroughfares, the area between the street and fence lines is public right-of-way and no signs may be placed in that area
$\square$ Political signs must be removed within ten (10) days after the election to which they pertain

# Role of the Norman Election Commission 

$\square$ Review City and State campaign contribution and expenditure reports
$\square$ Inform and educate the public on the reporting procedures
$\square$ Make a public report to City Council after each election
