Rates of return on these investments relate directly to current Treasury and Money Market rates. Total funds on deposit of \$174.89 million as of 02/28/13 are represented by working capital cash balances of all City funds of approximately \$87.58 million, outstanding encumbrances of \$31.45 million, General Obligation Bond proceeds of \$39.16 million, NUA revenue bond proceeds of \$8.45 million, NMA bond proceeds of \$782 thousand, and UNP TIF reserve amounts of \$7.47 million.
