City funds are invested in interest bearing accounts and investment securities, as directed by the City's Investment Policy. Rates of return on these investments relate directly to current Treasury and Money Market rates. Total funds on deposit of \$278.56 million as of 05/31/21 are represented by working capital cash balances of all City funds of approximately \$120.74 million, outstanding encumbrances of \$44.23 million, General Obligation Bond proceeds of \$42.01 million, NUA revenue bond proceeds of \$6.62 million, NMA bond proceeds of \$49.83 million, and UNP TIF reserve amounts of \$15.13 million.

The Governmental Accounting Standards Board requires the reporting of market values of investment securities. These market values represent the amount of money the security would sell for on the open market, if cash flow demands were such that the security had to be sold. The City of Norman purchases investment securities with the intent of holding them to maturity, as stated in the City's Investment Policy. Only in exceptional circumstances would securities be sold before their maturity, due to cash flow demands or favorable market conditions.
