

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, CLOSING THE PUBLIC
RIGHT-OF-WAY LOCATED BETWEEN LOTS 4, 5 AND 6
AND LOT 7, BLOCK 2, G.H. COLLEY'S 1ST ADDITION
TO NORMAN, CLEVELAND COUNTY, OKLAHOMA;
AND PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY THEREOF.
(601 NORTH PORTER AVENUE)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 1. That, pursuant to Resolution Number R-8182-66, Bison Ridge Investments, the owner of the subject property, has petitioned the City to have the public right-of-way (alley) on their property closed; and,
- § 2. That, also pursuant to Resolution Number R-8182-66, the proper notice has been given, and the maps, memorandums and other items required by said Resolution have been presented to this Council; and
- § 3. That, also pursuant to Resolution Number R-8182-66, a public hearing has been held regarding said closing; and
- § 4. That, the right-of-way, more particularly described as:

The particular public right-of-way and associated easement as it extends over the 601 North Porter property, as such public right-of-way is bordered on the west by Lots 4, 5 and 6, Block 2, and bordered on the east by Lot 7, Block 2, of G.H. COLLEY'S 1ST ADDITION (601 North Porter Avenue)

is hereby closed.

- § 5. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
