

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, SUPPORTING A REQUEST FOR FUNDS FROM THE ASSOCIATION OF CENTRAL OKLAHOMA GOVERNMENTS (ACOG) TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE LOCAL MATCH PORTION OF A CONSULTANT FEE FOR THE OKLAHOMA CITY AREA REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION STUDY (OCARTS) AREA STP-UZA CRITERIA AND PROCEDURES REVIEW AND UPDATE

- § 1. WHEREAS, the units of local government located in the Oklahoma City Area Regional Transportation Study (OCARTS) area, the Association of Central Oklahoma Governments, the Oklahoma Department of Transportation, and the OCARTS area transit providers are committed to the provision of a comprehensive, continuing, and cooperative transportation planning process in Central Oklahoma, as called for by the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, said entities have developed, through the Association of Central Oklahoma Governments (ACOG), the Metropolitan Planning Organization, STP-UZA Criteria and Procedures last updated and approved by the Intermodal Transportation Policy Committee and ACOG Board of Directors on October 27, 2016, to assist the Intermodal Transportation Technical and Policy Committees in assessing regional project priorities and in developing a financially reasonable program of STP-UZA projects; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Norman, Oklahoma, has determined, that the transportation needs of the area could be better served by reviewing and updating the OCARTS area STP UZA Criteria and Procedures to ensure alignment with regional goals and the changing needs of the metropolitan area; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, the City Council of Norman, Oklahoma, agrees to contribute \$2,355.50 towards the region's local match for ACOG to leverage federal PL funds to hire a consultant to review and create updated scoring criteria and procedures based on input from the units of local government in the OCARTS area, ACOG, ODOT and transit providers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 5. That the City Council of Norman, Oklahoma, is to contribute funds to the local match portion of a consultant fee for the OCARTS area STP-UZA Criteria and Procedures Review and Update.
