SUBJECT: High Priority Capital Needs

As requested at the December 13, 2012 PSST Oversight Committee meeting the Police and Fire departments have evaluated our current capital needs and identified those of the highest priority. This is not an exhaustive list intended to identify all Police and Fire needs for any given period of time but primarily addresses issues of immediate concern that are not likely to be adequately funded from other revenue sources in the foreseeable future.
