

A PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, PROCLAIMING THURSDAY, OCTOBER 6, 2016, AS PARKINSON'S AWARENESS DAY IN THE CITY OF NORMAN.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the courage, determination, and resilience of Parkinson's patients and families who live in our city continues to reflect the tenacious spirit of the City of Norman and the State of Oklahoma; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the City of Norman has become a leader in service to Parkinson's disease patients and families through the efforts of the Parkinson Foundation of Oklahoma and the Nicole Jarvis, M.D., Parkinson's Research Foundation as demonstrated by this inaugural Parkinson's Oklahoma 2016 Blitz of sixteen cities in 20 days and the annual gala; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, Parkinson's patients in the City of Norman have participated in such innovative programs as SPEAK OUT! Voice Therapy; LOUD Crowds; Parkinson's Wellness Recovery physical therapy; Rock Steady boxing for Parkinson's patients; as well as novel approaches to support and education, including the very first support group for Parkinson's patients in the state of Oklahoma.
