Re: NORMAN CENTRAL LIBRARY CO #003 EXPLANATIONS

The descriptions below are intended to explain the reasons for each change stated in C0 #003, and the associated costs for each change. Reference CO #003 for the formalized and signed document outlining these changes. Reference the potential change orders produced by Flintco Construction for the origination of stated costs.

## PCO-IORI - Relocate Generator Connection - \$25,786

Explanation: This PCO adjusted the location and type of the emergency generator connection. The original location was in the mechanical room. It was located there for cost efficiency as this was for emergencies only. The location of the generator was thought to be on Legacy Trail. During the 3D coordination of that that mechanical room it was suggested that the generator location be moved elsewhere as this room did not have room for access to the connection points. The original location was to move the connection to the exterior of the building. This would have added a large box to the east elevation which would have looked like an afterthought as well as put this connection in a more vulnerable location for tampering. It also did not address that the emergency generator would have been located on Legacy trail. The best solution for the building and for the future connection of an emergency generator is to locate the connection in the garage. This would allow a generator to sit outside the garage out of the way of traffic and easily connection to the panel inside the garage. This location was not put into the original documents as it was not the most cost effective solution and it was for emergency only use. This will add resiliency to the building in an emergency situation.

PCO-IIRI - Managing Storm Water due to Connection Delay at James Garner - \$2,196 Explanation: This PCO is necessary as the storm water connection to James Garner is unable to be connected because of the schedule of the James Garner Project. Flintco has been pumping the water off site per the direction of the CON.

## PCO-16 - Adjusting Reinforcing at Decorative Concrete - \$3,320

Explanation: This PCO addresses that the landscape etched design would not work well with the specification of a fiber reinforced concrete. The fiber reinforced concrete would leave a fuzzy finished in the etched areas. Flintco brought this to the teams attention. Going to a metal mesh rebar will allow a clean etched concrete design and will better bridge the transition of the engineered fill around the building and the natural soil conditions outside the building. This will add to the longevity of the sidewalk and is the best solution for the project.

Please see the GFRC mix design for the decorative sidewalks. The use of fiber mesh, in Flintco's experience, doesn't provide the structural stability that wire mesh and/or rebar would. In addition Flintco has found that owners don't like the exposed fibers that remain visible after surfacing. The batch plant estimator brought this to our attention first because he's received a lot of negative feedback on similar mix designs.

Per correspondence on 10/19 with MSR, please provide a revised mix design and corresponding reinforcing detail for the decorative concrete referenced above.

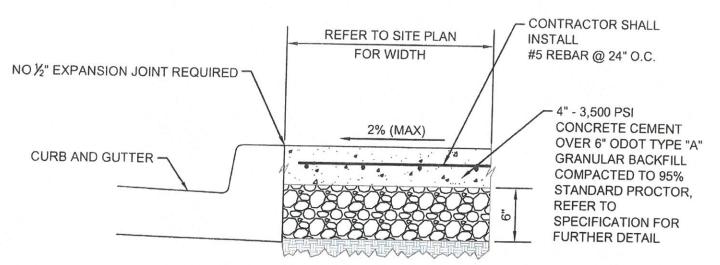

I wanted a chance to review a few things with our attorney in the City Attorney's office who helped develop the contract. The attorney and other staff in the Legal Department are engaged in a big meeting today, but I should have the opportunity to discuss tomorrow. After I discuss with her, we can either do a quick a conference call to finalize or I'll send an email.

Would it be easier to go ahead and process this Change Order without the delay days for now, and then bring them all up to date on the following Change Order so that we can discuss this and finalize it going forward?

I'm open to doing that if it's easier for the processing of this Change Order.

We have agreed to 17 rain days. Using calendar days that would move the date of substantial completion to June 29<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

We built our schedule around working 5 day weeks as per the City of Norman Statues and language in the contact that defines the "Time" of the work as: "All Work at the Site shall be performed during regular working hours Monday through Friday. Contractor shall not perform Work on Saturday, Sunday, or any legal holiday unless the Contractor submits a written request to the Owner which requests working outside of regular working hours, or on Saturdays, Sundays, or legal holidays..."

Thus the effect of losing five (5) work days is to lose a full week of work, or 7 calendar days.

The true effect on our work of 17 rain days is to push the date of substantial completion out to July 8th, 2019.

I understand the City of Norman and ADG are off for the Veterans Day Holiday, and will discuss this issue in their regularly scheduled Monday morning meeting.

We look forward to a quick resolution of this issue Monday, so on subsequent changes this will not be a point of discussion.

Section VIII. "Time" A.4. "All Work at the Site shall be performed during regular working hours Monday through Friday. Contractor shall not perform Work on Saturday, Sunday, or any legal holiday unless the Contractor submits a written request to the Owner which requests working outside of regular working hours, or on Saturdays, Sundays, or legal holidays..."

Our schedule was built around working 5 day weeks. We did not ask for a time extension for rain days for Saturdays or Sundays unless we had planned work for those days (Usually to make up for another rain day), or it the rain was so heavy that it shut us down for the next work day.

Please review the above references, and we will proceed with your decision.
