

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, APPROPRIATING \$25,000 FROM THE STATE SEIZURES AND RESTITUTIONS FUND BALANCE TO PURCHASE TWO (2) POLICE CANINES AND RELATED CANINE EQUIPMENT AND TRAINING.

- § 1. WHEREAS, in 2019, one police canine assigned to the Patrol Division was retired due to age and medical issues and in February, 2020, a Special Investigations Division Criminal Interdiction unit canine was put to sleep due to a serious medical issue; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes permits a district attorney to enter into agreements with municipal agencies to return to such an agency a percentage of proceeds of the sale of any property seized by the agency and forfeited under the provisions of Title 63 and for such proceeds to be used to purchase law enforcement equipment and provide law enforcement training.
- § 3. WHEREAS, an appropriation is requested to purchase two (2) canines with canine related equipment and training for personnel because the Police Department does not have funds budgeted for this purchase.
- § 4. WHEREAS, the canine and related equipment and training requested will maximize the investigative ability of personnel assigned to both the Patrol and Criminal Interdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 5. That the following appropriation be made for the reason as stated above.
