

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, ADOPTING THE ORIGINAL
TOWNSITE NEIGHBORHOOD PLAN AS AN
ELEMENT OF THE CITY'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the City of Norman recognized in the 2025 Land Use and Transportation Plan that the neighborhoods in the Core Area of Norman should be engaged "in a participatory planning process to directly address issues such as land use compatibility, parking, circulation, and neighborhood improvements;" and that the resulting plan developed from that process should be adopted by the Planning Commission and the City Council as an element of the City's Comprehensive Plan; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the Revitalization Division of the Planning and Community Development Department has completed a plan for the Original Townsite Neighborhood, and the Original Townsite Neighborhood Plan has been recommended by unanimous approval of the Planning Commission; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 3. That the proposed Original Townsite Neighborhood Plan as an element of the City's Comprehensive Plan be adopted for the area hereinafter described, to wit

Bounded by the south side of Gray Street, the east side of Porter Avenue, the north side of Alameda Street, and the west side of Reed Avenue.
