

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, AMENDING SECTION 460 OF CHAPTER 22 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NORMAN SO AS TO GRANT HISTORIC DISTRICT DESIGNATION ON A PORTION OF SOUTHRIDGE ADDITION AND CLASSEN-MILLER ADDITION, CLEVELAND COUNTY, OKLAHOMA; AND PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY THEREOF. (A TRACT OF LAND GENERALLY LOCATED BETWEEN MACY STREET ON THE NORTH, SHAWNEE STREET ON THE SOUTH, CLASSEN BOULEVARD ON THE WEST AND OKLAHOMA AVENUE ON THE EAST)

- § 1. WHEREAS, Paul Johnston, as agent and neighborhood representative for the Southridge Historic District and the owners of the hereinafter described property, have made application to have the property described below designated an Historic District overlay zoning district; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the Historic District Commission of the City of Norman conducted a public hearing as required by law and recommended adoption of an ordinance designating the property described below as an Historic District overlay zoning district; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the City of Norman conducted a public hearing as required by law and recommended adoption of an ordinance designating the property described below as an Historic District overlay zoning district; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Norman, Oklahoma, has considered the application and determined that the application should be granted and an ordinance adopted designating the property described below as an Historic District overlay zoning district.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 5. That Section 460 of Chapter 22 of the Code of the City of Norman, Oklahoma, is hereby amended so as to place the following described property in zoning classification Historic District of the City of Norman

Lots 24-34, Block 21; Lots 1-38, Block 22 of Classen-Miller Addition; and Lots 1-45, Block 1; Lots 1-48, Block 2; Lots 1-27, Block 3; Lots 1-13, Block 5; Lots 1-48, Block 6; Lots 1-48, Block 7 and Lots 1-20, Block 10 of Southridge Addition, City of Norman, Cleveland County, Oklahoma, said tracts of land containing 26.8 acres more or less.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
