BACKGROUND: This item is Replat of Lot 5, Block 1, University North Park Addition, Section 1, a Planned Unit Development, and is located at the southwest corner of the intersection of 24th Avenue N.W. and Mount Williams Drive. The original final plat for Lot 5, Block 1, University North Park Addition, Section 1, Planned Unit Development was approved by City Council on February 2, 2006 and contains a Super Target facility.

This property consists of 15.79 acres with two (2) proposed lots. The purpose of the replat relates to changing the boundary of the lot and creating two (2) lots. The new lot is proposed as a Schlotzsky's restaurant. Parking and circulation has been reviewed by staff.

The City Development Committee, at its meeting of March 25, 2015 reviewed the final site development plan and Replat of Lot 5, Block 1, University North Park Addition, Section 1, a Planned Unit Development.

DISCUSSION: All public improvements have been completed and accepted.
