

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN,
OKLAHOMA, CLOSING AND RELOCATING A UTILITY EASEMENT
LOCATED IN CARRINGTON PLACE ADDITION SECTION 11, NORMAN,
CLEVELAND COUNTY, OKLAHOMA; AND PROVIDING FOR THE
SEVERABILITY THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 1. That, pursuant to Resolution Number R-8182-66, Carrington Place, L.L.C., owner of the subject property, has petitioned the City to have the south five (5) feet of a ten (10) foot platted utility easement which abuts the north line of Lot 2, Block 5, CARRINGTON PLACE ADDITION SECTION 11 closed; and,
- § 2. That, also pursuant to Resolution Number R-8182-66, the proper notice has been given, and the maps, memorandums and other items required by said Resolution have been presented to this Council; and
- § 3. That, also pursuant to Resolution Number R-8182-66, a public hearing has been held regarding said closing; and
- § 4. That, the south five (5) feet of the ten (10) foot platted utility easement which presently abuts the North line of Lot 2, Block 5, CARRINGTON PLACE ADDITION SECTION 11, Norman, Cleveland County, Oklahoma, is hereby closed and relocated as follows:
- Said closed and to be vacated 5' easement portion to be relocated to abut on the North side of the five (5) foot platted utility easement which presently abuts the South line of said Lot 1, Block 5 (the "Relocated Portion"). Separate instrument easement E-1213-21 has been submitted and made part of this closure request.
- § 5. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
