

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, ACCEPTING THE LOWER IMHOFF CREEK STUDY FINAL REPORT.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the Storm Water Master Plan, which was accepted by the City Council in November 2009, identified a portion of Lower Imhoff Creek between State Highway 9 and a point approximately 2,000 linear feet north of Imhoff Road as IC-2;
- § 2. WHEREAS, IC-2 is an area experiencing severe stream bank erosion along both banks and requires the design and installation of stream bank stabilization measures;
- § 3. WHEREAS, on June 9, 2015, City Council approved Contract K-1415-134 with Meshek and Associates, LLC, to provide conceptual engineering design and recommended phasing of stream improvements for IC-2;
- § 4. WHEREAS, on June 30, 2017, Meshek and Associates, LLC, submitted the Lower Imhoff Creek Study Final Report which included several preventative and mitigation recommendations based on the data gathered during this study; and
- § 5. WHEREAS, Staff presented the findings and recommendations included in the final report during a Council Conference session on July 11, 2017, and requested that Staff prepare a resolution expressing formal acceptance of the study.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 6. That the Lower Imhoff Creek Study Final Report, attached herein as Exhibit A and made a part thereof be hereby accepted.
