STAFF REPORT

ITEM: Consideration of a Final Plat for <u>FOUNTAIN VIEW NORTH ADDITION</u>, A <u>PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT</u>.

LOCATION: Located at the southeast corner of the intersection of 48th Avenue N.E. and West Tecumseh Road.

HISTORY:

- 1. October 21, 1961. City Council adopted Ordinance No. 1320 annexing this property into the City of Norman.
- 2. <u>December 19, 1961</u>. Planning Commissioners recommended that this property be placed in the A-2, Rural Agricultural District.
- 3. <u>January 23, 1962</u>. City Council adopted Ordinance No. 1339 placing this property in A-2, Rural Agricultural District.
- 4. <u>February 2, 2012</u>. The Norman Board of Parks Commissioners, on a vote of 8-0, recommended fee in lieu of park land.
- 5. <u>February 9, 2012</u>. Planning Commission, on a vote of 7-0, recommended to City Council amending the NORMAN 2025 Land Use and Transportation Plan from Flood Plain Designation and Very Low Density Residential Designation.

HISTORY (cont'):

- 6. February 9, 2012. Planning Commission, on a vote of 7-0, recommended to City Council that a portion of this property be placed in the Planned Unit Development and removed from A-2, Rural Agricultural District.
- 7. <u>February 9, 2012</u>. Planning Commission, on a vote of 7-0, recommended approval of the preliminary plat for Fountain View North Addition, a Planned Unit Development.
- 8. <u>March 13, 2012</u>. City Council amended the NORMAN 2025 Land Use and Transportation Plan removing this property from Flood Plain Designation and Very Low Density Residential Designation to Low Density Residential Designation.
- 9. <u>March 13, 2012</u>. City Council adopted Ordinance No. O-1112-23 placing this property in the Planned Unit Development and removing it from A-2, Rural Agricultural District.
- 10. <u>March 13, 2012</u>. City Council approved the preliminary plat for Fountain View North Addition, a Planned Unit Development.
- 11. <u>June 14, 2012</u>. Planning Commission, on a vote of 9-0, approved the final plat for Fountain View North Addition, a Planned Unit Development.
- 12. <u>March 14, 2013</u>. Planning Commission, on a vote of 8-0, postponed a request to place a portion of this property in the Planned Unit Development and remove it from A-2, Rural Agricultural District.
- 13. <u>March 14, 2013</u>. Planning Commission, on a vote of 8-0, postponed the revised preliminary plat for Fountain View North Addition, a Planned Unit Development.
- 14. <u>April 11, 2013</u>. The applicant has made a request to amend the NORMAN 2025 Land Use and Transportation Plan from Very Low Density Residential Designation to Low Density Residential.
- 15. <u>April 11, 2013</u>. The applicant has made a request to place a portion of this property in the Planned Unit Development and remove it from A-2, Rural Agricultural District.
- 16. <u>April 11, 2013</u>. Planning commission is scheduled to consider the preliminary plat for Fountain View North, a Planned Unit Development.

IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM:

1. <u>Fire Hydrants</u>. Fire hydrants will be installed in accordance with approved plans. Their locations have been approved by the Fire Department.

- 2. <u>Permanent Markers</u>. Permanent markers will be installed prior to filing of the final plat.
- 3. <u>Sanitary Sewers</u>. Sanitary sewer mains will be installed in accordance with approved plans and City and Department of Environmental Quality standards.
- 4. <u>Sidewalks</u>. Sidewalks will be constructed adjacent to 48th Avenue NW. The owner/developer proposes sidewalks adjacent to the private streets.
- 5. <u>Storm Sewers</u>. Storm sewers and appurtenant drainage structures will be installed in accordance with plans and City drainage standards. Detention facilities will be constructed throughout the development. They will be maintained by a Property Owners Association.
- 6. <u>Streets</u>. Although private, interior streets will be constructed in accordance with approved plans and City paving standards. Currently 48th Avenue N.W. is designated as a minor arterial street and will be constructed as a collector street. Staff recommends deferral of street improvements for 48th Avenue N.W. based on the lack of connecting facilities. If constructed, it would become a "piece meal" paving and could be removed in the future, with a project. As a result, it is not in the city's best interest to require the improvements to be constructed at this time.
- 7. <u>Water Mains</u>. Water mains will be installed in accordance with approved plans and City and State Department of Environmental Quality standards. An off-plat twelve-inch (12") water main has been extended and connected to an existing twelve-inch (12") water main parallel to West Tecumseh Road.

PUBLIC DEDICATIONS:

- 1. Easements. All required easements are dedicated to the City on the final plat.
- 2. Rights-of-Way. All street rights-of-way are dedicated to the City on the final plat.
- **SUPPLEMENTAL** MATERIAL: Copies of a location map, preliminary plat, final site development plan, final plat, and memorandum for deferral of street improvements for 48th Avenue N.W. are included in the Agenda Book.
- STAFF COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATION: This property consists of 84 senior adult lots and several open space lots that will be maintained by a mandatory Property Owners' Association. Staff recommends approval of the final plat for Fountain View North Addition, a Planned Unit Development.
- **ACTION NEEDED:** Approve or disapprove deferral of paving and drainage improvements for 48th Avenue N.W. and the final plat for Fountain View North Addition, a Planned Unit Development.
