ORDINANCE NO. O-1920-64

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, AUTHORIZING THE CALLING AND HOLDING OF A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF NORMAN, STATE OF OKLAHOMA (THE "CITY"), ON THE 25th DAY OF AUGUST, 2020, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE REGISTERED QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF SAID CITY THE QUESTION OF THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF SAID CITY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THE SUM OF FIVE MILLION DOLLARS (\$5,000,000) TO BE ISSUED IN ONE OR MORE SERIES TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT IN NORMAN, INCLUDING RETENTION AND CREATION PROGRAMS; ALL TO BE COMPLETED WITH OR WITHOUT THE USE OF OTHER FUNDS, AND LEVYING AND COLLECTING AN ANNUAL TAX. IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER TAXES. UPON ALL THE TAXABLE PROPERTY IN SAID CITY FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE INTEREST AND PRINCIPAL ON SAID BONDS; PROVIDED HOWEVER, THAT IN NO EVENT SHALL THE REAL AND PERSONAL TAXABLE PROPERTY IN SAID CITY BE SUBJECT TO A SPECIAL TAX IN EXCESS OF FIVE MILLS ON THE DOLLAR FOR ALL BONDS ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION 35. ARTICLE X OF THE OKLAHOMA CONSTITUTION: PROVIDING FOR **ELECTION** PROCEDURES: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATED THERETO.

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by The City of Norman, State of Oklahoma (the "City") to provide funds for the following purpose:

(i) <u>Economic and Community Development</u>: To provide funds for the purpose of economic and community development in Norman, including job retention and creation programs; and

WHEREAS, the estimated amounts necessary for such purposes as listed above are as follows:

(i) <u>Economic and Community Development</u>: Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00); and

WHEREAS, there are no funds in the treasury for such purposes, and power is granted said City by Section 35, Article 10, of the Oklahoma Constitution and laws of the State of Oklahoma, to issue bonds to provide funds for such purposes, provided the same is authorized by the registered qualified voters thereof, voting at an election held for such purpose.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. <u>PROPOSITION</u>. That the Mayor of the City, or in her absence or incapacity, the duly qualified Mayor Pro Tempore, be and hereby is authorized and directed to call a special

election to be held in the City on the 25th day of August, 2020, for the purpose of submitting to the registered qualified voters of the City, for their approval or rejection, the following proposition:

PROPOSITION

Economic and Community Development Projects

Shall The City of Norman, State of Oklahoma, incur an indebtedness by issuing its bonds in the sum of Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) to provide for the purposes of economic and community development in Norman, including job retention and creation programs, with or without the use of other funds, and levy and collect a special tax, payable annually in addition to all other taxes, upon all the taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds as it falls due, and also to constitute a sinking fund for the payment of the principal thereof when due, said bonds to bear interest at not to exceed the rate of ten percentum (10%) per annum, payable semi-annually and to become due serially within twenty-five (25) years from their date; Provided however, that in no event shall the real and personal taxable property in said City be subject to a special tax in excess of five mills on the dollar for all bonds issued pursuant to Section 35, Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution?

SECTION 2. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECTS AND USE OF PROCEEDS.

Proposition– Economic and Community Development Projects

The Economic and Community Development Projects for which the proceeds of the aforesaid not to exceed \$5,000,000 Economic and Community Development Bonds shall be loaned, granted or expended to or for qualified economic and community development purposes as defined in Title 62, Section 802 of the Oklahoma Statutes, as amended, specifically, as a funding source for the Economic Recovery Program, and for expenses of the bond issue. Guidelines will be established by the City which will assure accountability and adherence to sound economic and community development standards. Proceeds of the Economic and Community Development Bonds may be expended with or without the participation by other economic and community development agencies and entities, but to the extent federal funding is awarded to the City for similar economic and community development purposes, such federal funding will offset the authorization set forth herein.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. <u>ELECTION PROCEDURES</u>. That with respect to the election to be held on August 25, 2020:

a. The number and location of the polling places, the hours of opening and closing of the polls, and the names of the officers who shall conduct the election shall be the same as the

regular polling places and persons prescribed and selected by the Cleveland County Election Board, for elections in Norman, Oklahoma.

- b. That the Special Election Proclamation and Notice of even date, a copy of which is on file with the City Clerk and which is incorporated herein by reference, calling said election is hereby approved in all respects, and the Mayor or Mayor Pro Tem is hereby authorized to execute said Special Election Proclamation and Notice on behalf of the City, and the City Clerk or Deputy City Clerk is hereby authorized to attest and affix the seal of the City to said Special Election Proclamation and Notice, and to cause a copy of said Special Election Proclamation and Notice to be published as required by law, and a copy thereof delivered to the Cleveland County Election Board.
- c. That the City Clerk shall serve or cause to be served, a copy of this Ordinance and the Special Election Proclamation and Notice upon the office of the Cleveland County Election Board at least seventy-five (75) days prior to the date of the election, as required by law.
- d. Pursuant to Title 62, Section 896.1, the City Clerk is hereby directed to publish such project information related to the City's outstanding general obligation bonds, if any, and project information related to the proposed general obligation bonds to be voted upon on August 25, 2020, in accordance with the Bond Transparency Act of 2017.
- <u>SECTION 4.</u> <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE</u>. It is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City, and the inhabitants thereof that the provisions of this Ordinance become operative immediately and therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage and approval by the City Council, subject to approval by the registered qualified voters of the City at a special election as set forth herein.
- <u>SECTION 5</u>. <u>SEVERABILITY</u>. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
