

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, AUTHORIZING AND APPOINTING
RDNJ, L.L.C., D/B/A A-TECH PAVING, AS PROJECT AGENT
FOR THE DAWS-THONHAWA ALLEY PAVEMENT
IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FROM NEBRASKA STREET TO
HUGHBERT STREET

- § 1. WHEREAS, the City of Norman, Oklahoma, does hereby acknowledge that the tax-exempt status of this political subdivision is a significant factor in determining the agreed contract price bid by Daws-Tonhawa Alley Pavement Improvement Project; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the City of Norman, Oklahoma, in compliance with State law, desires to confer on Daws-Tonhawa Alley Pavement Improvement Project, its special State and Federal sales tax exemptions and in order to achieve such end, finds it necessary to appoint as its direct purchasing agent, RDNJ, L.L.C., d/b/a A-Tech Paving, to purchase materials which are in fact used for the Daws-Tonhawa Alley Pavement Improvement Project and
- § 3. WHEREAS, this limited agent status is conferred with the express understanding that RDNJ, L.L.C., d/b/a A-Tech Paving, shall appoint employees and subcontractors as subagents who shall be authorized to make purchases on their behalf.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 4. That the City of Norman, Oklahoma, on the 22nd day of October, 2019, did appoint RDNJ, L.L.C., d/b/a A-Tech Paving, who is involved with the Daws-Tonhawa Alley Pavement Improvement Project, an agent of the City of Norman, Oklahoma, solely for the purpose of purchasing, on a tax-exempt basis, materials and tangible personal property to be used exclusively for the Daws-Tonhawa Alley Pavement Improvement Project.
