A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, CHANGING A STREET NAME FROM DEBARR AVENUE TO DEANS ROW AVENUE IN LARSH'S UNIVERSITY ADDITION IN THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the final plat of LARSH'S UNIVERSITY ADDITION, to the City of Norman, Oklahoma, was recorded with the Cleveland County Clerk on September 10, 1901; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the LARSH'S UNIVERSITY ADDITION filed of record included a street that is approximately 1,100 feet in total length located between Boyd Street and Duffy Street designated as DeBarr Avenue; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, by City Policy adopted in 2008 by Resolution No. R-0809-60, the process for changing a street name requires submission of a petition containing signatures of at least seventy-five percent (75%) of the property owners adjacent to the street being changed and payment of a \$200.00 application fee; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has received a petition from persons wishing to change a current street name from DeBarr Avenue to Deans Row Avenue that contains the signatures of at least 75% of the property owners adjacent to DeBarr Avenue and the application of \$200.00; and
- § 5. WHEREAS, Public Works Department has determined that the proposed name, Deans Row Avenue, is acceptable because it is not a duplicate, vulgar, will not cause confusion with another street name by Emergency Services, and meets current U.S. Postal addressing criteria; and
- § 6. WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has verified property ownership records against the petition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 7. That by the authority of the Council of the City of Norman, Oklahoma, to review and approve resolutions including street name changes, the street name of DeBarr Avenue located in Larsh's University Addition is now changed and will be known as Deans Row Avenue.
- § 8. Said street name change to become effective no later than 30 days from date of adoption.
