A PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, PROCLAIMING THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, 2012, AS NATIVE AMERICAN HERITAGE MONTH IN THE CITY OF NORMAN.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the American Indian population residing within the City of Norman proper represents a unique and diverse population representing many tribal nations; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, this unique population provides a learning experience not available to many towns, cities, and communities; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, the American Indian population of the City of Norman is represented within every facet of the City including, but not limited to, primary, secondary, and higher education; business; non-profits; federal, state, and tribal services; the health field; fine arts; industry; the armed forces; religion; law enforcement; and entertainment; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, the American Indian population has contributed to the growth and future of the City of Norman; and
- § 5. WHEREAS, the beauty and richness of the American Indian culture provides a dynamic presence in the City of Norman that attracts visitors from across the State, nation, and internationally; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

§ 6. Do hereby proclaim the month of November, 2012, as Native American Heritage Month in the City of Norman and call this to the attention of all residents and encourage them to recognize the contributions made by American Indians to the community.
