A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, AMENDING THE NORMAN 2025 LAND USE AND TRANSPORTATION PLAN SO AS TO REMOVE PART OF THE NORTH HALF OF SECTION TWENTY-SIX, TOWNSHIP NINE NORTH, RANGE TWO WEST OF THE INDIAN MERIDIAN, TO NORMAN, CLEVELAND COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, FROM THE SPECIAL ENTERPRISE AREA DESIGNATION AND RETAIN THE COUNTRY RESIDENTIAL DESIGNATION. (3900 EAST ROBINSON STREET)
