Rates of return on these investments relate directly to current Treasury and Money Market rates. Total funds on deposit of \$253.04 million as of \$1730/20 are represented by working capital cash balances of all City funds of approximately \$100.12 million, outstanding encumbrances of \$49.16 million, General Obligation Bond proceeds of \$47.05 million, NUA revenue bond proceeds of \$12.12 million, NMA bond proceeds of \$28.97 million, and UNP TIF reserve amounts of \$15.62 million.

Only in exceptional circumstances would securities be sold before their maturity, due to cash flow demands or favorable market conditions.
