

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN,  
OKLAHOMA DECLARING PROPERTY FROM THE ROBINSON STREET  
GRADE SEPARATION PROJECT AS SURPLUS PROPERTY.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the City of Norman, Oklahoma (“City”) entered into an agreement with the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (“ODOT”) dated October 25, 2005 (the “Agreement”) for a Grade Separation Project at West Robinson Street, over the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railway Company’s tracks (the “Project”); and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the Agreement provides that the City will, in its own name, acquire the interests in real estate necessary for the Project in compliance with the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970 as amended by the Surface Transportation and Uniform Relocation Assistance Act of 1987; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, the City of Norman acquired such interests in real estate and the Project was substantially completed December 2012; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, there are three parcels of property, identified on the attached map as Parcels A, B, and C, that were acquired as part of the Project; and
- § 5. WHEREAS, these parcels are no longer needed by the City of Norman for the successful functioning of the Project, and the City of Norman is currently responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of the parcels; and
- § 6. WHEREAS, the City Council Planning and Transportation Committee met on December 17, 2012 to review options regarding the possible uses for the parcels, potential benefits to the City of Norman if the parcels were sold and returned to private ownership, and the legal process to sell the parcels; and
- § 7. WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Norman to declare the parcels as surplus property.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN,  
OKLAHOMA:**

- § 8. That City of Norman declares that Parcels A, B, and C, originally part of the Project, are surplus and may sold at a public auction.
