SUBJECT: Claim from Dennis Bloye

I am in receipt of a claim from Dennis Bloye in the amount of \$2,182.96 for damages to his vehicle due to his claim that on May 15, 2017, his parked vehicle was struck by a City of Norman sanitation truck at 3708 Astor Drive. According to the police report, a City of Norman sanitation truck, driven by Robert Rohr, was pulling away from having picked up two polycarts at the house to the west of Mr. Bloye when a vehicle drove around the sanitation truck causing the sanitation driver to serve to the right to avoid striking it; however, that action caused the sanitation truck to strike Mr. Bloye's parked vehicle. Mr. Bloye states the accident report is inaccurate and has provided video footage of the incident, which appears to contradict the Police Report. A copy of the video is saved in the Public Folder/Information Technology folder, and entitled "video."

Ken, I would appreciate your checking with your staff regarding verification of the problem. Please report your findings by written memorandum to me with a copy to Jeff.

Jeff, if it is determined the City has liability in this matter, please signify by writing a report of your recommendations in order that we may schedule this claim as an agenda item.
