AMENDMENT NO. 3 TO CONTRACT FOR DESIGN CONSULTANT SERVICES

("Authority"), and its successors in interest, and PDG, LLC. d.b.a. Planning Design Group	("Design
Consultant").	

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the City and the Design Consultant entered into a contract on March 14, 2017 entitled:

DEVELOPMENT AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE GRIFFIN PARK SPORTS COMPLEX

WHEREAS, additional funding was made available to provide for additional work by the Design Consultant team as outlined hereinto develop construction drawings for a new Multi-Departmental Maintenance Facility based on the results of the Master Planning process; and

WHEREAS, these improvements include a Transit & Fleet Maintenance facility that consists of a 17,500 SF with vehicle service bays and support spaces, including an attached 1,745 SF cleaning bay for cleaning of vehicle interiors and large equipment / parts. It also includes the accompanying site elements, such as pavement, fencing, site lighting and other components. Based on preliminary cost estimates, the anticipated construction budget for this structure will be \$3,842,000.

A Parks Maintenance facility consisting of a 18,900 SF building with vehicle storage bays and equipment service bay and support spaces. It also includes the accompanying site elements, such as pavement, fencing, site lighting and other components. Based on preliminary cost estimates, the anticipated construction budget for this structure will be \$2,920,000.

A Fire Department Reserve Storage facility consisting of a 4,900 SF building with vehicle storage bays and support spaces. It also includes the accompanying site elements, such as pavement, fencing, site lighting and other components. The estimate construction budget for this portion of the complex is \$947,000.

Last, The Fleet Vehicle Wash Building facility consists of a 2,259 SF building with automatic vehicle wash equipment and self-serve pre-wash & vehicle cleaning equipment. It also includes the accompanying site elements, such as pavement, fencing, site lighting and other components. The estimated construction budget for this portion of the complex is \$862,000; and

WHEREAS, the original contract must be amended to incorporate the Design Consultant's work as described herein and associated fees; and

WHEREAS, the total compensation to be paid to the Design Consultant for this Contract and Amendment shall be as follows:

For the original Contract:

Not to exceed \$761,000 for Design Consultant services

For Amendment No. 1:

Not to exceed \$430,280 for Design Consultant services

For Amendment No. 2:

Not to exceed \$120,000 for Design Consultant services

For Amendment No. 3:

Not to exceed \$316,370 for Design Consultant services

Total Amended Contract:

Not to exceed \$1,627,650 (an increase of \$316,370) for all services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree to amend the Contract as follows:

I. Amend Paragraph 2. **Basic Services.** to read as follows:

Basic Services. The Design Consultant is hereby engaged and employed by the City to perform in accordance with good Design Consultant practices and in the best interest of the City all of the work as set out in the Original Contract and herein as outlined in item III, amended Exhibit A – Scope of Work, incorporated as a part of this Contract:

II. Amend Paragraph 4. **Compensation.** to read as follows:

<u>Compensation</u>. The aggregate total compensation for all Design Consultant services under this Contract shall not exceed a total fee of \$1,627,650 (an increase of \$316,370) for Basic Services as specifically set forth Exhibit B, attached hereto and incorporated herein.

It also includes the accompanying site elements, such as pavement, fencing, site lighting and other components.

Partial payments of the not to exceed amounts for each task may be invoiced for incremental work completed. Not to exceed amounts below are accumulative for successive tasks.
