## CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL SESSION MINUTES

## February 12, 2013

The City Council of the City of Norman, Cleveland County, State of Oklahoma, met in Special Session at 5:30 p.m. in the Municipal Building Conference Room on the 12th day of February, 2013, and notice and agenda of the meeting were posted in the Municipal Building at 201 West Gray and the Norman Public Library at 225 North Webster 48 hours prior to the beginning of the meeting.

DISCUSSION REGARDING CHANGE ORDER NO. TWO TO CONTRACT NO. K-1213-3 WITH OPES, INC., INCREASING THE FYE 2013 CONCRETE PROJECTS CONTRACT AMOUNT BY \$26,906 TO ALLOW FOR COMPLETION OF THE SIDEWALK ON THE WEST SIDE OF SHERRY AVENUE FROM IOWA STREET TO CRESTMONT AVENUE TO ACCOMMODATE PEDESTRIANS AROUND CLEVELAND ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

On July 24, 2012, City Council approved Contract No. K-1213-3 for the FYE 2013 Concrete Projects to OPES, Inc., in the amount of \$169,269.25 and Change Order No. One increasing the contract by \$13,730.75 for a total contract amount of \$183,000. This contract included four (4) concrete sidewalk programs:

Citywide Sidewalk Reconstruction Program	\$ 70,000
Sidewalk Accessibility Program	\$ 25,000
Sidewalk Program for Schools and Arterials	\$ 38,000
Downtown Area Sidewalks and Curbs Program	\$ 50,000
	\$183,000

Mr. Scott Sturtz, City Engineer, said this change order will add \$26,906 to the Sidewalk Program for Schools and Arterials to allow the completion of sidewalk construction on the west side of Sherry Avenue from Iowa Street to Crestmont Avenue to accommodate pedestrians around Cleveland Elementary School including Americans With Disabilities (ADA) accessible ramps. He provided photographs of the project site plan at the north entrance at Cleveland Elementary School, the Cleveland School driveway at the northwest corner of Iowa Street and Sherry Avenue, and the sidewalk on the south side of Iowa Street across from the school which at this time are not handicap accessible.

Mr. Sturtz said a fund transfer for the FYE 2013 Sidewalk Program for Schools and Arterials would be required and it is recommended that a transfer in the amount of \$14,276 be made from the FYE 2012 Driveway Repair Program and \$12,630 be transferred from the FYE 2013 Driveway Repair Program.

Councilmember Gallagher asked if these improvements were to be done at all elementary schools.

Mr. Shawn O'Leary, Director of Public Works, said Staff works with Norman Public Schools to identify areas where sidewalks are needed. He said there are two different programs. This program that is included in the Capital Budget and Safe Routes to School Program is funded with federal funds via the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT).

Councilmember Williams asked how much money remains in the Driveway Repair Program. Mr. O'Leary said \$6,550 remains in the FYE 2013 Budget and \$5,820 has been spent to date.
