I am in receipt of a claim from Vincent L. and Carolyn Sue Peters in the amount of \$2,680.00 for damages to their vehicle due to their claim that on July 19, 2017, a City vehicle struck their vehicle. According to the accident report, Mr. Henry Weilmuenster, Parks and Recreation Department, was stopped at the traffic light in the northbound lane of University Boulevard and Mrs. Peters was stopped in the right turn lane of University Boulevard. When the light turned green Mr. Weilmuenster began a right turn striking Mrs. Peters vehicle. Mr. Weilmuenster stated he needed to turn right, but was pulling a trailer and needed a wide turning angle so that is why he was not in the right turn lane. After checking his mirror and seeing no vehicles he began a right turn striking Ms. Peters vehicle.

Jud, I would appreciate your checking with your staff regarding verification of the problem. Please report your findings by written memorandum to me with a copy to Jeff.

Jeff, if it is determined the City has liability in this matter, please signify by writing a report of your recommendations in order that we may schedule this claim as an agenda item.
