

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA,
RENAMING THE NORMAN POLICE DEPARTMENT FIREARMS RANGE AS
THE LT. ROYCE O. WEDDLE NORMAN POLICE FIRING RANGE.

- § 1. WHEREAS, Lt. Royce O. Weddle served the citizens of Norman for over 20 years as a member of the Norman Police Department; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, Lt. Weddle won the annual Oklahoma National Rifle Association Police Revolver Championship 14 out of the 20 years he participated; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, Lt. Weddle won five National Rifle Association Regional Police Combat Revolver Championships; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, Lt. Weddle won the U.S. National Rifle Association National Police Department Revolver Championship in 1975; and
- § 5. WHEREAS, Lt. Weddle won the National Shooters League National Championship with a record-setting score in 1977 and was the captain of the winning 4-man team in the municipal category of the National Rifle Association National Pistol Championship in 1979; and
- § 6. WHEREAS, Lt. Weddle placed four consecutive years in 1981-1984 in the Bianchi Cup Invitational National Rifle Association Action Pistol Championship; and
- § 7. WHEREAS, Lt. Weddle was the Norman Police Department gunsmith from 1973-1983 and built and maintained firearms for the Norman Police Department SWAT Team and Pistol team; and
- § 8. WHEREAS, Lt. Weddle was instrumental in the development and construction of the Norman Police Department Firing Ranges; and
- § 9. WHEREAS, the City Council Community Planning and Transportation Committee reviewed and recommended City Council approval of a request to rename the Norman Police Department Firearms Ranges at 3942 Jenkins Avenue to the Lt. Royce O. Weddle Norman Police Firing Range.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 10. That the Norman Police Department Firearms Ranges at 3942 Jenkins Avenue be renamed to the Lt. Royce O. Weddle Norman Police Firing Range in honor of the accomplishments, commitment and service of Lt. Weddle in the development of the Norman Police Firing Range and the established success and advancement of the Norman Police Department competitive firearms teams.
