With the right of ingress and egress to and from the same, for the purpose of surveying, laying out, constructing, maintaining, and operating a <u>PUBLIC WATER LINE</u>.

Grantee herein covenants and agrees that work performed in connection with installation, maintenance and repair of the facilities shall not disrupt existing utility services. Further, Grantee shall schedule any unavoidable shutdown of water services (including those related to the switchover from the old waterline to the new, replacement water line) after 12:01 AM to minimize disruption to Grantor's operations.

Grantee further covenants and agrees that at all times during Grantee's installation, maintenance and repair of the Facilities, and excepting the hours between 12:01 AM and 8:00 AM, Grantee shall ensure that at least one (1) lane of traffic remain open and usable from the entry drive and through the front of the parking lot of the Grantor's Property. Grantee shall exercise its rights hereunder in a manner as to not unreasonably interfere with the business operations being conducted on Grantor's Property. Once initial construction begins, Grantee shall diligently and continuously pursue to completion any installation, maintenance and/or repair of the Facilities.

Grantee covenants and agrees to pay all costs associated with its installation, maintenance and repair of the Facilities, including the cost of any work necessary to return the Grantor's property, as much as possible, to its condition immediately prior to installation of the Facilities. Grantor may continue to use and enjoy the surface of the Easement Property for all purposes that do not materially interfere with or interrupt the use or enjoyment of the Easement by Grantee; however, in no case shall a permanent structure be erected by Grantor in a location or in such a manner that will materially affect or impede Grantee's access to the Facilities..
