AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA AMENDING ARTICLE V OF CHAPTER 14 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NORMAN BY ADDING A PROVISION AUTHORIZING THE CLERK OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT TO CHARGE AND COLLECT A TECHNOLOGY FEE; AND PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

§ 1. That Article V of Chapter 14 of the Code of the City of Norman be amended to add Sec. 14-508 to read as follows:

Sec. 14-508. Technology Fee.

A municipal court technology fee shall be and is hereby established in the amount of Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00). The fee shall be in addition to and not in substitution for any and all costs, fees, fines or penalties otherwise provided for by law and assessed on every citation disposed of in the municipal court except standing and parking and those that are voided, declined for prosecution, dismissed without costs, or the defendant is acquitted. The revenues generated by this fee shall be used solely and exclusively for the acquisition, operation, maintenance, repair, and replacement of data processing equipment and software related to the administration of the municipal criminal justice system and the costs of prosecution.

§ 2. <u>Severability.</u> If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance, except that the effective date provision shall not be severable from the operative provisions of the ordinance.
